Oxford comma

I like writing and reading,
steak and potatoes, and
long walks on the beach.

* To separate two independent clauses with a conjunction

I like steak, but it gets in
my teeth.

I like singing, but I don't
like dancing.

Separate independent and dependent clauses

[After school ^{dep} yesterday], I
went to Kroger.
ind.

an hour.
