
## Vocabulary Crossword

Learning Target: I can determine or clarify the meaning of unknown or multiple meaning words.


**Assignment:** You will use your vocabulary words and definitions to create a crossword puzzle. This activity will help you in recognizing the correct definition for the words, the proper use of the words, and in learning to spell the words correctly.

**Scoring:** Creating your puzzle is worth 25 points, and accurately completing your partner's puzzle is worth 25 points. You will lose 1 point for each mistake. The total score for this formative assessment is 50 points.

**Process:** 1. <u>Planning</u>. On a sheet of notebook paper, begin placing your words in boxes for your



2. <u>Numbering</u>. Each word will be assigned to either "Down" or "Across". If two words begin at the same point, they will have the same number (i.e. 1 down, 1 across).



3. <u>Clues</u>. Using your definitions, write a clue for each word on your crossword puzzle. Your clues should be placed in the "across" or "down" column, depending upon where the word is located in your puzzle. You could also choose to include fill-in-the-blank sentences as clues, as long as you include a word bank.
