The Simon Wiesenthal Center's chief Nazi hunter, Efraim Zuroff, commented that "The verdict [of John Demjanjuk, a former Nazi death camp guard,] sends a very powerful message that, even many years after the crimes of the Holocaust the perpetrators can be brought to justice. . . We're hopeful that this verdict will pave the way for additional prosecutions in Germany."
